- July 29 - Mary and Martha of Bethany and Dorcas as examples of workers in congregational ministries of education, property, service, feeding and fellowship.
- August 5 - Lydia and the women of Luke 8, CEO's and CFO's, congregational presidents, property managers, and leaders in church and community.
- August 12 - celebrate the feast of St. Mary, mother of Our Lord together with remembering the miraculous moms Hannah, Sarah, and Elizabeth and the vocation of raising families.
- August 19 - lift up Deborah, Jael, Esther, and Miriam as leaders in military, government, and the arts.
- August 26 - the examples of Ruth and Naomi, Eunice and Lois who show us the vocation of nourishing relationships in home and community.
